HOW TO GET TO PERISHER

When you arrive in the Perisher Ski Tube building, attend the 4SITE Perisher Guest services desk to organise your oversnow transfers to the lodge.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT TIMES

Check-in is 3:00 pm. Lodge facilities are NOT available before this time.

Check-out is 10:00 am.

Guests who wish to ski on the day of arrival or departure may store their luggage at the lodge while they go skiing. Management takes no responsibility for any luggage stored at the lodge.

LATE ARRIVALS

Please advise the booking officer if you will be arriving after 6:30 pm. Due to Food Safety Regulations meals cannot be held for late arrivals.

KEY CODE

The front and back door of Barina Milpara Lodge are protected by a key access code. This is provided by the bookings officer prior to your stay at the Lodge.

Tea, coffee and hot chocolate are available at all times.

GUEST LAUNDRY:

A washing machine and dryer are available for guests use. Washing powder is provided.

INTERNET

Wi-Fi is available for guests use.

ROOM PROVISIONS

Bed linen and towels are provided. Every room has its own bathroom and heater. Ski boots may not be brought into the lounge or guest's rooms.

GUEST ETIQUETTE

- The ski and board storage area is accessed by the back door of the lodge.
- There is a separate drying room for outerwear and ski boots.
- Waxing of equipment is NOT permitted.
- Guests may not enter the kitchen.
- Guests set and clear their own tables.
- Alcohol can be purchased at the licensed supermarket in the Skitube terminal building.
- Fridges are available at the lodge for storage of cold drinks
- Common areas are to be left clean and tidy after use.
- Guests are responsible for the behaviour of their children and are expected to show respect to others for the quiet enjoyment of the lodge.
- Managers set and light the fire in the evening. Guests are to ensure the fire is safe when they go to bed at night.
- In the event of unacceptable behaviour the directors reserve the right to ask guests to leave.
